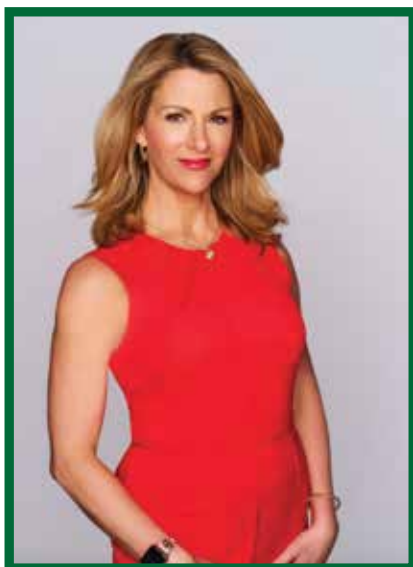

KAREN HEPP

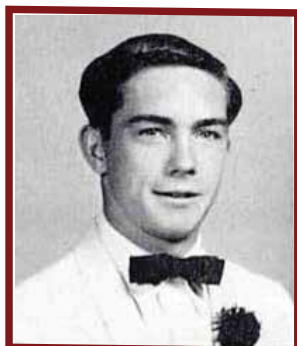
Our Toastmaster for this year is none other than Karen Hepp, Co-Ancor of

Karen is a graduate of New York University and is married with three boys.



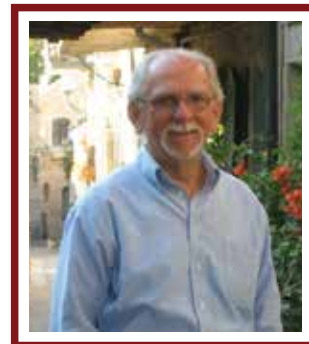
THOMAS THOMSON '62

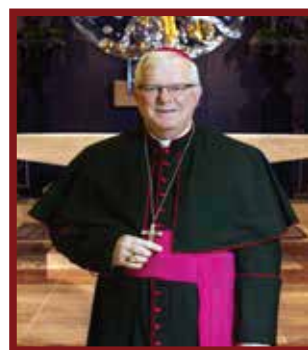

Chaplain's Corner

NECHS Alums,

It was an honor to be asked to serve as the new chaplain for the NECHS Alumni Association and to follow in the footsteps of Father Neil Kilty. I consider it a privilege to serve.

To begin I offer a true story which may serve as an introduction. As you know, I was the Principal at North from 1982 to 1992. You may not know that I was the Principal at Judge from 2011 to 2017. (What I did in between is the grist for another story.) It was my practice at North to interview the students who received four or more failures at the end of a report card period. The parents were required to attend. I had a set speech and provided an improvement plan. If the student appeared receptive, he remained. Otherwise, he was instructed to clean out his locker. I have lost count of how many of these interviews were held.

The years passed and I decided to use the same kind of interview at Judge. At the end of one of these sessions, I asked if there were any questions or comments. The student's father spoke up. "Son, listen to what the Father said. He told me the same thing when I was at North twenty years ago." I am happy to report the father did eventually graduate from North, and his son did eventually graduate from Judge. Both needed a bit of prodding. Who knows, perhaps the father is reading this story and can verify it?

Like the story, the Alumni Association looks back to the past, to fortify the future. By supplying scholarships to young persons pursuing a Catholic education, you are touching the future more than you know. I offer a "Thank You" from your former teachers and the scholarship recipients. It is good to be associated with a group of men with such vision. *(continued)*

I would like to bring to your attention the Cause for the Canonization of Rev. John F. Harvey, OSFS '36, founder of Courage, the spiritual support group for persons with same-sex attractions. He died in 2011 at the age of 92. He is not the first North alum to be considered for a proclamation of sainthood, but his cause, I believe, is the most current. Visit the website www.frjohnharvey.com. On the website, the section "A Profile in Courage" provides a video of Father Harvey's service to the church. To become a member of the "The Father John Harvey, OSFS Guild" you need to pledge to say one Hail Mary daily for the opening of the cause for canonization.

Please pray for the three recently deceased Oblates, all with a North connection: Fr. Geroge Martyn, Fr. Robert Ashenbrenner, and Fr. John Mokiuk. You may have shared your life with one or more as a classmate or a student. May they rest in peace. Their good works go with them.

A quote from St. Francis De Sales: ***We do not very often come across opportunities for exercising strength, magnanimity, or magnificence; but gentleness, temperance, modesty, and humility, are graces which ought to color everything we do.***

Continue to have a good Lent and a Happy Easter.

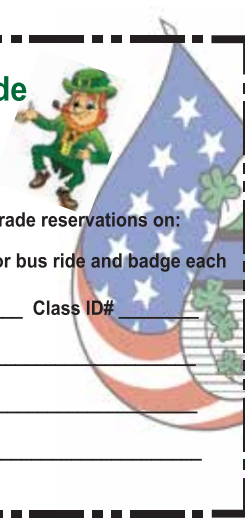
